

ECE441 Webpage Specifications

Requirements:

1. Your project webpage must contain the following information on its front/main page.
 - a. Project Name
 - b. ½ page (300-400 word) Project Description
 - c. Student Names and an email link
 - d. Mentor Name
 - e. Sponsor Name
 - f. A place to track page changes/updates to the web pages
2. Somewhere in your pages you also need at least the following items. These should not be on the main page, but linked from there.
 - a. Student Bios with Picture
 - i. Student Bios should be 200-300 words each and include details an employer would be interested in as well as local news agencies (hometown, siblings, live goals, etc...)
 - ii. Student Resumes
 - b. Copies of submitted documents (PDF)
 - i. Once a document is posted, it should not be replaced. Instead make a new link for an updated version.
 - c. Reference Links
 - i. All links here should be to 'hard addresses' or consist of locally copied files.
 - d. Other areas important to your project
 - i. Examples could include photo archive, mechanical specifications, a wiki, code repository, etc...
3. All documents must be posted in Adobe PDF or as needed Microsoft Excel spreadsheets. You may post other formats if you would like, but you must at least have these to formats for EVERY document.
4. You should pay special attention to having a professionally appearing webpage. This is likely the only chance you will have time to work on it, so try to make it as nice as possible now. FYI, blinking red text is NOT professional.
5. We have intentionally not given you a template to work from, please be creative with your design.
6. Your webpage needs to be fully functional from both Internet Explorer and Firefox.
7. If you are not familiar with web development, there are many tools available for your use. Do NOT use MS Word to make webpages. Instead use other products like MS FrontPage, NVU, Dreamweaver, vi, etc...
8. Your webpage must be located in the location provided, not in your personal webspace
9. Engineering support does not allow the use of CMS or Wikis in these spaces. Please utilize only html, PHP, and Java.
